

In the United States, surrogacy laws vary from state to state. Nevada is one of the most surrogacy-friendly states, with laws that allow all hopeful parents (single, married, straight or gay) to be listed on the baby's birth certificate.

Las Vegas enjoys a warm, arid climate and averages 294 days of sunshine per year. The humidity averages a low 22%, and even on very hot days, there is usually a breeze. The average temperature is 66.3 degrees F (19 degrees C), so visitors don't have to worry about weather affecting their travel plans and flights.

# Bruce Shapiro Md, Phd, FACOG, HCLD

Founder and Medical Director



A well-known and respected fertility research pioneer, board certified reproductive endocrinologist Dr. Shapiro founded The Fertility Center of Las Vegas in 1988. His commitment to ongoing innovation has made The Fertility Center of Las Vegas one of America's leading forces advancing the science and practice of reproductive endocrinology, but it's his friendly and caring bedside manner that has helped make The Fertility Center of Las Vegas an Oasis of Hope for people needing medical help to grow their families.

Dr. Shapiro's commitment to his patients has led to the development of new techniques to make IVF safer and more effective. His

award-winning research has been widely published in respected medical journals, and some of the procedures he has helped innovate have been adopted as the standard of care by physicians around the world. For example, he was one of the first U.S. physicians to perform and report on blastocyst transfer, which allows the transfer of fewer embryos to the uterus while maintaining high pregnancy rates and reducing the risk of multiple pregnancy (twins or greater). This procedure, and Dr. Shapiro's many other innovations, have greatly improved the chances of IVF success for countless men and women hoping to have a baby.

Dr. Shapiro completed his residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Yale New Haven Hospital, finished his fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility at Yale University and earned his PhD at the University of Amsterdam in the Netherlands. In addition to his work at The Fertility Center of Las Vegas, Dr. Shapiro remains on the faculty as Director of the Division of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility at the University of Nevada School of Medicine, where he teaches medical students and residents.

## Carrie Bedient MD, FACOG

### Reproductive Specialist



As Nevada's first female board certified reproductive endocrinologist, Dr. Bedient feels privileged to help men and women reach their full family-building potential. A champion of reproductive freedom, Dr. Bedient is particularly interested in fertility preservation for patients undergoing toxic therapies for medical conditions such as cancer, as well as third party reproduction for same-sex couples and LGBT individuals. Known for her kindness and warm bedside manner, Dr. Bedient is a role model for empathy, compassion, respect, altruism and integrity in medicine.


Dr. Bedient excels at research, and investigates the causes of infertility and improved protocols in advanced reproductive technology. Her recently published papers and book chapters have focused

on frozen versus fresh embryo transfers, the use of robotics in reproductive surgery, adolescent fertility preservation and a comparison of robotic and laparoscopic myomectomy.

After graduating from the University of Arizona College of Medicine, she completed her residency at Case Western Reserve University & Cleveland Clinic Foundation Metrohealth Medical Center, followed by fellowship training in reproductive endocrinology and infertility at Emory University. She has pursued advanced training in minimally invasive surgery to correct uterine anomalies, endometriosis and other gynecological issues. Dr. Bedient also serves as a clinical assistant professor at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology.





Before moving to Las Vegas, Stella grew up in Northern China and has lived and studied in France, Cameroon, and Brazil. Stella moved to the United States and joined FCLV in 2020 and has become a valued member of our team helping Chinese speaking patients on their journey to parenthood.


# Oasis of Hope
